A. and Ph. D. Programmes in Buddhist Studies.

The University desires to invite knowledge and wisdom from all ten directions and provide a suitable platform to the scholars and researchers for healthy interaction among south and South-East Asian countries and facilitate cross pollination of ideas and foster harmony among various civilizations of the world. - Admission process & other conditions as per the Admission Rules and Procedure of the SUBIS.
- Candidate should keep visiting regularly the University website for necessary information, it will be applicable for Khajuraho Study Centre also.
- Admission to the Ph.D. Program will be intimated on University Website separately.
- Foreign / NRI / PIO student shall be exempted from MA / MSC / MFA and Ph.D. entrance examination.

Admission Rules for Foreign/NRI Students (M. A./M.Sc./M.F.A. and Ph. D. Programmes)

The Sanchi University of Buddhist-Indic Studies shall admit Foreign/NRI students to the M. A. and Ph. D. Programmes/Courses of the University on full time basis. All Foreign/NRI students shall be exempted from the entrance examination and shall have to appear in Viva-Voce only. The qualifying marks in the Viva-Voce examination shall be 50%.

The minimum educational qualification for admission of Foreign/NRI candidates in various programmes of the University is same as for Indian candidates. Candidates admitted to any course in this University shall not be eligible to pursue simultaneously any other full time course in this or in any other University/Institution. All the Foreign/NRI students shall require a Student Visa, No Objection Certificate, Medical Test (HIV test) Medical Insurance endorsed exclusively to Sanchi University of Buddhist-Indic Studies for joining full time Programme/Course. No other endorsement is acceptable. Besides, other Indian rules applicable to Indian students will be applicable to Foreign/NRI students as well.

Reservation of Seats:

For P.G. Programmes: Minimum 10% of the total seats for each P.G. Programme shall be made available for Foreign/NRI students.

For Ph.D. Programme: Minimum 10% of Foreign/NRI students in a year shall be admitted to Ph.D. Programme.


